Minutes

1. Update on Operations-Biggest thing since last meeting, found leak in electronics container. Bud did temporary patch, will need to do a more permanent patch after winter. Most likely will get a tar product to seal. We now have a couple extra fuses for the compactors as well. All the new magnetic signs are up. Ice has been a bit of an issue on the recycle compactor area, in terms of roll off and on.
2. Budget overview-Year to date, we have spent \$5,492.18 on solid waste and recycling expenses, 5% of anticipated budget. We have also brought in \$11,323.70, or 8% of expected revenue.
3. Update on GFL Contacts-Carrie Hansen is our new go to person for day-to-day operations and reports, with Lisa Faschingbauer as our second contact.
4. Yearly Maintenance-Everything is currently working well. Slight issue with fuse blowing in one of the compactors. The fuse has been replaced a couple times, but attendants think they have found a few situations when its more likely to blow. They do not feel its necessary to call someone out currently. Clerk to touch base with JWR to see if they have a time later this year to come out and do maintenance. Clerk will also contact surrounding communities to see if we can arrange a date for the area.
5. Hazardous Waste Event-Bryant Sears got back to Bud, \$2,000 to come for 4 hours. He said we would need to go over logistics. Contact townships after April to see who is interested. Look to do this late summer, possibly August to give us time to coordinate logistics and also market well.
6. Snow Plowing-Public Works is continuing to have to come out and widen the lanes, and push snow back. If public works is not able to accommodate plowing the collection station, we would need to work on a better agreement to address how much snow needs to fall before plowing would be appropriate. Would prefer public works take over if possible.
7. Resident Permit Charges- There have been some concerns/complains from residents about getting charged for garbage for double lots. We're thinking of getting some type of form to submit for board approval to take the garbage charge off. There are lots of factors that need to be addressed before we can get started on this. Such as what situation qualify to have the garbage charge removed.
8. Replacement Passes & Cost-\$10 charge after January.
9. Holiday Hours Update- Would like to propose to board to have holiday schedule printed on back of permits.
10. Update on Lights for New Compactor-Couldn't find suitable standard to hold light in the air, so Badger Electric is going to make one. Once done, it will be put up.
11. Review/Update Meeting cadence-continue with the 2-month meeting.
